
Colour Disc



You will need:-

Cardboard, slightly larger than the colour circle Glue Scissors 1m of fine string



Method

- 1). Stick the colour circle page onto cardboard and then cut round the colour circle.
- 2). Make a hole along the join between the red and green areas 1cm from the centre. Make a second hole on the opposite side and also 1cm from the centre.
- 3). Thread fine string through the first hole and then loop it round and thread it back through the second hole.

- 4). Tie together the two ends of the string and move the colour circle to the middle of the string loop.
- 5). Take one end of the loop in each hand and twirl the colour circle around a few times until the string is twisted.
- 6). Pull the ends of the string apart and notice what happens to the colour wheel.
- 7). Alternate pulling and relaxing should keep the colour wheel spinning for a long time.

Note how the three colours merge to form a uniform white colour once the disc is spinning faster than the eye can follow.
