Balance Bird 1

(Design 'borrowed' from elsewhere on the internet)

Make a model bird to balance on the tip of your finger.

YOU WILL NEED:

balancing bird sheet, two pennies, clear sticky tape, hot melt glue scissors colouring supplies





SAFETY:

Scissors are sharp - ensure that you do not cut or pierce yourself when using these. Hot melt glue is very hot and will hurt if you get any on your fingers. Report any injury.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1). Do any colouring you want.
- 2). Cut out the bird and tail. Ensure to cut along the wing lines that go into the body area.
- 3). Fold the bird in half.
- 4). Use a small amount of hot melt glue to the inside of the eye and beak area of the head and stick together.
- 5). Make a slight crease along the lengths of the wings to stiffen them.
- 6). Insert tail piece and secure with hot melt glue if necessary.
- 7). Use sticky tape to temporarily attach a penny on the underside of each wing. Check the balance of the bird. Adjust the position if necessary.
- 8). When the pennies are in the correct place, use a small amount of hot melt glue to secure them into place.
